



PROCEDURE OF SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

Attested Photocopies of following documents be submitted within the period as specified in the advertisement.

- A. (1) Certificate and marksheet of 10th/Hsc., Intermediate & Graduation.
 - (2) Certificate and marksheet of Post Graduation examination (if passed).
 - (3) Nativity / Permanent Residential Certification of Jharkhand Issued by S.D.O.
 - (4) Cast Certificate in case of SC, ST or OBC issued by S.D.O.
 - (5) In case of PH candidates, PH certificate issued by C.S.
 - (6) NCC, Games and sports certificate at state/ national level competition.
- B. (1) One recent stamp size coloured photograph to be firmly pasted to the form at specified space.
 - (2) Two self addressed post cards.
 - (3) Two stamped envelope of Rs. 5 of 24 x 10 cm size.
- C. (1) All the above certificates in original shall be produced for verification/ submission at the time of admission.
 - (2) Five copies of recent stamp size colour photographs.
 - (3) C.L.C./ D.L.C. issued by the institution last attended.
 - (4) Migration certificate if the candidate has passed the last examination from the university other than V.B.U. Hazaribag.
 - (5) All inservice candidates shall submit their duty leave certificate from their employer.
 - (6) An affidavit sworn before a notary Public that all information given by them are true.

RULES FOR ADMISSION

- 1. Admission shall be taken on merit basis as per marks obtain from Secondary level to onwards.
- 2. Only such candidates will be eligible to be considered for admission, who have passed their graduation level examination with two school subjects and have obtained a minimum of 50% marks for General Category & 45% for marks OBC/SC/ST in the qualifying examination from a recognised university.
- The selection of candidate for admission to B.Ed. course will be done strictly in accordance with the merit list prepared on the basis of rules and regulations of Govt. of Jharkhand candidates will be assigned merit points on the basis of marks obtained at each examination matriculation to post graduate level.

PLEASE NOTE:

Candidates of the following background will not be considered for admission.

- (1) Candidates who have appeared for the Final Year Grduation examination and are awaiting results.
- (2) Candidates who have received the marks from the cross list only.
- (3) Candidates who have already been enrolled for other courses viz-Computer Science, Management Training Programme, Competitive exams or any other.
- (4) Pregnant women and mothers with children below 2 years.
- (5) Incomplete, furnishing false information & late application form will be summarily rejected without any information to the candidate concerned.
 The College management reserve the right to reschedule the programme of admission etc.
 If needed may refuse admission to any candidate unsuitable for valid reason.

ATTENDANCE AND PERIODICAL EXAMINATION

Student must be regular in attending in classes including Practical and internship 75% attendance in each subject and 80% attendance in seminars, group discussion, tutorials, Practice teaching, Craft practical, demonstration etc. is compulsory for appearing in the university examination.

Regular monthly and terminal examination shall be conducted throughout the B.Ed. course as per academic Calender of the College.

In case of absence from any examination without any reasonable ground which is not satisfactory to the college administration the students shall not be allowed to appear in the university examination of B.Ed.

MISCONDUCT AND INDISCIPLINARY ACTS

Violation of the following rules will be taken as the code of misconduct.

- 1. Damaging the College property inside or outside the college.
- 2. Use of abusive slogans.

- 11. Disruption of teaching, study, Examination or administrative works, co-curricular activities or residential life of the members of the college.

- 3. Rejection of admission/ derolled from the admission register.

IDENTITY CARD:

Each and every student will have to obtain his/her identity card duly signed by the Principal from the respective office counter Every Students must carry his/her identity card with him/ her and will have to produce the same on demand inside or outside the college Campus.

MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

The medium of instruction would be Hindi/ English but students will be required to answer their questions in the university examination in the languages or languages prescribed by the Vinoba Bhave University, Hazaribagh, Jharkhand.

FEE STRUCTURE

The students selected for admission are required to deposit at the time of admission the college fee as applicable in Vinoba Bhave University, Hazaribagh.

LIBRARY RULES:

The college is furnished with a rich and informative library comprising of renowned books and nation wide accepted in Journals to enhance teacher's education.

During college hours, library is opened to all the students perusing their B.Ed. Study from the institution. A library is meant to satisfy the thirst for knowledge. To enable this task certain rules are required to be followed for conduct of discipline for benefit to all. These rules will help in creating necessary condition under which the library in the modern sense can be established and maintained adequately to serve the needs of users. The rules are appended below:-

- Students must bring library card complete with photo identification duly attested by librarian and principal with them.
- 2. The books will be issued only when the library card is produced before the librarian.
- 3. Books can be issued only on personal card.
- 4. Student must maintained pin drop silence in the library.
- 5. Books will be issued only for 15 days students charged@ 1 Rs. per day as a late fine.
- 6. When the book issued to the borrower is damaged or destroyed he/she will have to pay the fine.
- 7. Student are strictly prohibited to bring the personal books and their belongings.
- 8. If a student wants to keep the book for more than 15 days, the book will be re-issued to

him/ her on the decision of librarian.

9. If the library card is lost by the student he/she will have to pay Rs. 30 for getting duplicate library card.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- A student admitted to Kumar B.Ed. College, Dhanbad must maintain an ethos of commitment to a professional programme. He/She is expected to aim at excellence in every spheres and conduct himself/ herself in a responsible and dignified manner in the college campus.
- 2. Class attendance is must for Board Examination. The college expect them to attend above 75% classes.
- 3. The trainee must attend all demonstration classes during the course as well as his/ her scheduled practice Training Classes during January / February practice teaching period. The trainee is expected to teach in any school assigned by the college authorities.
- 4. All the trainees have to attend all college functions and activities such as cultural functions, seminars, symposia, debates, quizzes, essay competitions, sports, picnic, community services, exposure programmes etc.
- 5. Educational tour is a part of training programme and all the trainees have to join it.
- 6. Prior permission is required from the Principal for any absence either from theory or practical classes and community life activities. Application should be made for leave in writing.
- It goes without saying that no commitment (competitive exams, computer course, private tuitions, University exams) should be undertaken during the regular college timings of classes and activities.
- The student's name is liable to be dropped from the rolls, if he/she is absent continuously
 for more than 10 days without leave. A re-admission fee will be charged, if re-admission is
 granted.
- 9. The college has a well maintained library of books and periodicals. Every student is expected to make the best use of it making sure, however, to observe the library rules fully.
- 10. The trainees are expected to take proper care of the college property and help in maintaining the premises neat and tidy.
- 11. The conduct of a trainee in the classes as well as on the premises of the college will be such, that will cause no disturbance to fellow or to other class.

- 12. The college Dress Code:-

- 13. If for any reason the continuance of a trainee in the college is, in the opinion of the principal, determination to the best interests of the college, the principal may ask such student to leave to college without giving reason for her/his decision.
- 14. The student, who secure admission on the basis of false certificates, Mark sheet or on the basis of any misrepresentation of facts or illegal means, shall be summarily cancelled; all fees paid by him/her shall be forfeited. Legal action shall also be taken against them.


